**October 27 – *The Incredible Shrinking Man* (1957)** Environmental toxins transform an ordinary guy. From Richard Matheson's sci-fi novel.

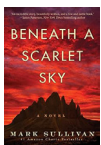

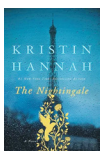
### ***Beneath a Scarlet Sky* by Mark T. Sullivan**

### ***Good Night, Irene* by Luis Alberto Urrea**

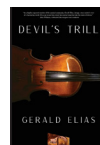
Follow the story of a young woman's heroic frontline service in the Red Cross during WWII.
