

invites you to participate in our first-ever UOSL Bookmark Contest. Winners will have their design printed on bookmarks and shared with students across the state of Utah!




Your Mission

COMPLETE CONTEST RULES

The Utah's Online School (UOSL) Library Bookmark Contest is produced by Utah Education and Telehealth Network (UETN). The Contest begins on or about April 9, 2025 and ends with the announcement of winners on or about May 19, 2025. This Contest consists of one round of judging. To enter the contest, you may submit your entry to UETN, Attn: Jasmin Valdivia, 101 Wasatch Dr., Rm 215, Salt Lake City, UT 84112 or submit your entry on the UOSL Bookmark Contest website. All entries must be received by May 9, 2025 to be eligible. These Contest rules are subject to modification by UETN at its discretion. Sponsored and coordinated by UETN located at 101 Wasatch Dr., Salt Lake City, UT.

Eligibility & Entry Guidelines

- Bookmark design must be original.
- Submissions must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, or other intellectual property rights of others.
- Entrants must be Utah students in kindergarten, first, second, third, fourth, fifth, or sixth grade
- Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify ineligible entries; such entries will not be returned. Only
 one entry per person will be accepted in this Contest; all subsequent entries will be disqualified.

Official Entry Form

- Each entry must include the official UOSL Bookmark Contest Entry Form, with the required signature of a parent/guardian, consenting to allow their child/ward to enter the Contest, confirming that the design and art are original, and granting certain rights to the entry materials.
- The entry form must be complete and legible to be eligible.
- Bookmark designs submitted by mail must be created on one side of the paper and numbered on the back of each page.

Judging, Awards & Notification

All entries submitted to the Contest will be judged using the judging criteria and percentages below by a panel of no fewer than 3 judges selected and coordinated by UETN. Judging will occur on or about May 9, 2025.

The judging criteria and percentages shall be scored and graded using a rubric based on the following criteria:

40% Creativity and originality 40% Use of "Hidden Gems" theme 20% Quality and originality of design

All decisions of the judges are final and binding and not subject to appeal or review.

Winners will be as follows: There will be two winners selected: (1) the entry with the highest score from all eligible K-2 grade submissions will be designated as the First Winner; (2) the entry with the highest score from all eligible 3-6 grade submissions will be designated as the Second Winner.

In the event of a tie, the entry with the highest score in the creativity and originality and/or use of "Hidden Gems" theme from among all tying entries will be deemed the winner from among all tying entries. Winners will be notified on or about May 19, 2025.

Return of Entries

The contest administrators may make reasonable efforts, but are not required, to return mailed entries. UETN is not responsible for late, lost, stolen, misdirected, damaged, mutilated, incomplete, returned, or illegible entries, or postage-due mail.

Rights Associated with Contest

Submission of the Entry Form constitutes permission from the participant's parent/legal guardian for UETN to use the participants' name, likeness, biographical information, information and materials contained in the Entry Form, photographs, and any statements or remarks made about the Contest in advertising and promotion without further compensation or permission, except where prohibited by law. All entries, and any copyrights therein, become the sole property of UETN. By entering, entrants' parent/legal guardian agree to abide by the above stated rules, and warrant that their child's original work and does not infringe upon or violate rights of any third party, and grant to UETN the right to edit, publish, promote, and otherwise use the child's entry materials without permission, notice or compensation. No royalties will be paid at this or any time. By submitting an entry and Entry Form, each participant's parent/legal guardian, on behalf of the participant, assigns all right, title, and interest in and to the entry and Entry Form to UETN and warrants that the participant's parent/legal guardian has the authority to assign such right, title, and interest. In the event that any applicable law requires certain formalities to be fulfilled to effectuate such grant of rights, each participant (and parent or guardian) agrees to cooperate with UETN to achieve fulfillment of such formalities. By submitting an Entry Form, each participant's parent/legal guardian, on behalf of the participant, agrees to be bound by these Contest Rules. Each participant's parent/legal guardian, on behalf of the participant, agrees to release and hold UETN and its employees, officers, directors, shareholders, agents, representatives, subsidiaries, parent companies, or other affiliated companies harmless from any and all damages, losses, claims and liabilities arising out of participation in the Contest or resulting from acceptance or claiming of any prize hereunder. UETN reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate, suspend or otherwise cancel the Contest at any time. Income and all other taxes are the responsibility of the prize recipient. UETN is not responsible for any expenses incurred in connection with participation in the Contest.
